## CHAMBER HONORS ROTARY



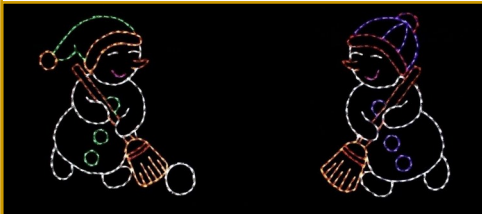
