### August 10 Program — J. Burt, North Central Regional Betterment Coalition

Derek Fetzer introduced J. Burt who serves as President of the North Central Regional Betterment Coalition (NCRBC). Their mission is to develop initiatives that create viable cultural, educational, and economic opportunities in North Central Illinois. They were founded about 20 years ago and are a 100% volunteer organization. Studies have shown that our local area has an overabundance of low skilled, low wage jobs with a small number of people having a degree or education beyond high school. Currently, they are in the midst of "Words Matter," an advocacy campaign designed for children to start life on a faster track. If kids get a better start, they have a better chance of reaching their potential, and they can stay ahead. This means more qualified people to work in our businesses. The concept is simple - introducing kids from birth forward to reading. Even though they may not understand the words, by the age of 3, children will have been exposed to 30 million words! NCRBC has teamed up with local groups and businesses to get books into the hands of new parents, and they are asking for help. Can our Rotary Club offer help - Financial? Elbow grease? Or do we know who can help? Another initiative of NCRBC included the Discover Manufacturing Career Expo, a cooperative with IVCC, Starved Rock Associates Vocational & Technical Education (SRAVTE), and local manufacturers. J. shared the website ([ncrbc.net](http://ncrbc.net)) and their Facebook page that is filled with additional information.
