August 17 Program — Josh Taylor of Taylor's Way

Tracy Grimmer introduced Josh Taylor, one of our newest Rotarians, for our program. Josh is a Princeton native, having graduated from PHS in 1999 before studying and graduating from the University of Illinois at Chicago with a mechanical engineering degree. Josh worked in the field for 10 years before returning to Princeton in 2012. He and his wife, Jamie, have 3 sons, 2 dogs, and a cat. Josh gave a brief history of the transformation of the family business from Taylor's Lawn Care (started in the 1970s by Buster & Kay Taylor) to Taylor's Natural Green Lawn, followed by Taylor's Trees & Turf. In 2019, the business became known as Taylor's Way. The company took a "deep dive" into their core values and future, developing a vision and purpose statement. They are proud to focus on the client experience and proactive care and prevention. Their values include knowledgeable and friendly people, family, and accountability. It's a family business and employees are considered part of the family. Taylor's Way provides plant health care covering turf, trees, and shrubs as well as tree trimming and removal. In 2019, they added pest control which became a full service in 2021. This year, they plan to expand to add Christmas light decorations to their menu of services. The company has 28 employees, including 6 ISA certified arborists, with 2 more taking the certification test soon. They boast over 4,000 clients as of March 2021 and serve a 50 - 60 miles radius covering Peoria, Morris, Geneseo, and surrounding areas. Plans are for a future location in Peoria in the next 12 - 18 months.

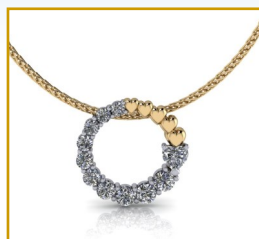
