Several area first responders are taking part in the parade in remembrance of the 20th anniversary of 9/11. Michael noted that there will be a display of 50 years of parade floats inside the former Centru Bank building on Friday at 5 p.m. and throughout the weekend. The Homestead Festival parade is one of the oldest festival parades in Illinois, and our own Steve Bouslog will be this year's grand marshal. Rotary is also sponsoring a float in honor of our 100th club anniversary! The entire parade boasts 107 entries this year! 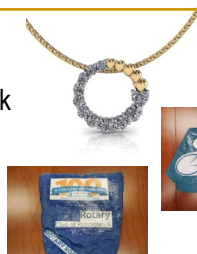
