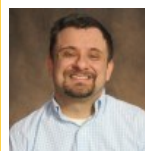

**August 24 Program — Eric Brown of RAMP CIL**

Tracy Wright introduced Eric Brown, Education & Advocacy Coordinator for RAMP CIL. Eric shared that their Center for Independent Living (CIL) covers Boone, DeKalb, Stephenson, and Winnebago Counties. There is a local CIL in LaSalle - Illinois Valley Center for Independent Living - that provides similar services in our area. The concept behind a CIL is to assist people with all types of disabilities to control and direct their own lives. Eric noted that 25% of the population has a disability, and anyone can wake up tomorrow and be part of the disability community. Eric covered such topics as communicating with people with disabilities, providing reasonable accommodations, physical access and ADA requirements. Of note are simple things such as speaking to the person with a disability and not his/her caregiver or companion and asking if assistance is needed before trying to help. When advertising on social media, businesses and groups can easily add captions to videos and descriptions with photos; this will allow customers with hearing or visual impairments to fully engage.
