October 5 Program Trisha Schafer Freedom House

Joe Kitchens introduced Trisha Schafer, the manager for outreach and facilities at Freedom House. Trisha shared that they opened in 1983 and provide domestic violence and sexual assault services which includes counseling, education, and an emergency shelter - among other things. They have 32 beds in the shelter and serve 80 - 150 people per year there. All services are free and confidential. An increase in domestic violence was definitely seen during COVID with people being at home more, along with added stress and financial issues. She shared some staggering statistics and noted that video and phone counseling services were added during the pandemic. Trisha concluded her presentation by reading a client impact statement and showing three videos that are also shared on their website and Facebook.
