January 4 Program - Tammy Lange Bureau County Metro Center

Joe Kitchens introduced Tammy Lange, Executive Director of the Bureau County Metro Center, and a fellow Rotarian. Tammy shared that 95% of Americans make resolutions and at 3 months about 10% remain focused. The top 3 include exercising more, losing weight, and getting more organized. Metro Center staff provide support, help people feel welcome, and assist with setting reasonable goals. Tammy said it's important to establish a routine and choose a workout buddy. She shared information about their hours, services that include the walking track, weight room, pool, cardio room, racquet ball court, and many classes that are available without a membership.
