March 15 Program - Bureau County Genealogical Society
Cathy Foes introduced Elaine Newell, program director and vice president of the Bureau County Genealogical Society for

the past 29 years! Elaine noted that the Society has existed for 32 years and began in 1990 with a small collection of a few records. In 2005, they expanded to their own building. Visitors are able to search through all records. Last year, they had 217 people who did some research, whereas before the pandemic the number was 400 - 500. Visitors have come from most states, Canada, Germany, and Sweden. There is no charge to visitors, unless they request photocopies. The local Society has a Facebook page with a video that Elaine encouraged everyone to view. She spoke about the fact that birth and death records were not recorded until 1916 in Illinois, but they have access to a number of cemetery records providing this information. In April, the 1950 census records will be available, as the 72 year privacy law will have expired. Other onsite records include a marriage index, county farm records, ancestry

A membership is available for \$15/year (\$17 for a family). The Society is seeking volunteers; they have 15 at present. The work is fun and rewarding. The Bureau County Genealogical Society is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit and relies on donations and local support; no tax dollars are allocated to them.
