**March 1 Program**  
**Patrick Lilley—Princeton Moose Lodge**

Joanne Sheldon introduced Patrick Lilley, administrator of the Princeton Moose Lodge. He has been the administrator for the past 13 years and has held many other positions and titles since becoming involved with the Moose Lodge years before that. When he's not at the lodge, Patrick is a truck driver and commented that most people in the area know of his family through their trucking company. Patrick then spoke of the history of the Moose Lodge. First established in Louisville, KY in the spring of 1888 by Dr. Henry Wilson, it was known as a men's social club. By 1906, there were only 2 lodges left with 7 attendees at the convention. James J. Davis became involved and the Moose grew to 1,000 clubs and more than 500,000 men within 2 years. Along the way, Mooseheart was established in 1913 to serve children. Moose Haven then grew out of the membership to provide a retirement community
