Angela Reidner, CNM
Catching Joy Midwifery**

Tracy Grimmer introduced her guest, Angie Reidner. Angie, a certified nurse midwife,

shared a little about herself and her family before talking about her extensive medical experiences. Angie worked with Dr. Lavavej for 10 years before going to IVCH Women's Healthcare for 9. She then had the opportunity to do OB/GYN teaching in a family medicine residency program for 4 1/2 years in St. Louis. She said this was one of the largest hospitals in the U.S. delivering over 10,000 babies each year. About 8 months ago, she made the decision to return to Princeton to open a home birth practice, Catching Joy Midwifery. Angie shared information about advance practice nurses and said they have "full practice authority" in 36 states. This means they can function without direct supervision within the scope of their practice, and it allows providers to meet the needs of their rural communities (one of the key lobbying points that led to the successful legislation). Angie said her practice is highly personalized. Since opening in January 2022, she has assisted
