Pam Pratt Marsh introduced her guests, J.D. & Janice Smallwood, to talk about their business. J.D. spoke to the history of Norberg Memorial Home, indicating they broke ground at their current location in 1968. His father was his inspiration to get into the business, and he began working with him as soon as he could. During the height of the pandemic, Janice said they saw the impact that isolation had on families. They offered drive-thru and online funeral services and learned a lot of different skills. It was hard for families to not have the hugs and personal touch from others as the number of people present was very limited. The couple spoke of the services they can offer including bracelets with fingerprints of the deceased, other jewelry items, family handprints on a casket, a variety of urns, and custom stones.

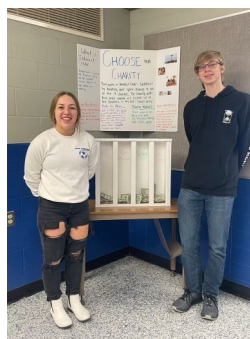
