Cathy Foes introduced Jennifer Junis, Senior Vice President of OSF On Call

Digital Health. Jennifer began by sharing their vision – OSF OnCall is an always-available digital care platform providing individuals with what they need to navigate their health and wellness journey, wherever they are. Jennifer talked about their guiding principles and shared information about her leadership team. She gave examples of their digital experience (new tools and navigation), digital care (the ability to remotely monitor a patient at home or in the hospital), and on demand services (in-person modern urgent care and virtual visits). Jennifer showed a map with the locations for OSF services and introduced "Clare," an AI driven chat bot who many people may have seen if they use OSF MyChart options. Clare is loaded with the same protocols as nurses and can guide patients and offer advice. Jennifer wrapped up her presentation by sharing some statistics related to digital health and how patients have benefited. For example, more than 16,000 patients received outreach about scheduling a
