Cathy Foes introduced Tom Cox, Director of Radiology, Radiation Therapy, and Cancer Services at OSF HealthCare. Tom began his presentation with a video showcasing patients' stories and the desire to have a cancer center in Peoria. The OSF HealthCare Cancer Center will provide for all needs locally and eliminate the need for patients to travel away from family and friends for treatment. Tom talked about the cancer continuum - prevention and education, assessing risk, screening and early detection, timely diagnosis, evidence-based best practice treatment, and survivorship/surveillance.
