 Michael Zearing &

 Princeton Historic
 Preservation
 Commission**

Joe Kitchens introduced Michael Zearing who currently serves as the Chair of the Princeton Historic Preservation Committee. Michael talked about the north and south end historical districts and encouraged Rotarians to visit the City of Princeton website for more information. He shared several locations that have significant history including the Red Covered Bridge, train depot, and Lovejoy Homestead. This committee has also gotten involved in brick street preservation, as well as building preservation and advocacy. They are currently working with the City with regard to Princeton Tire and Sophisticuts, two historical buildings with some structural issues. Michael said the committee also is involved in preservation seminars and plans to begin offering home and garden tours in the spring of 2023. The goal is to use the trolley to visit 6 homes around Princeton to share the history. Michael Stutzke then talked about the plaque program that he introduced to the committee after living in Florida and
