**August 2 Program
Theresa Murphy
OSF HealthCare
Foundation**

Cathy Foes introduced Theresa Murphy, Director of Strategic Philanthropy at OSF HealthCare Foundation. Theresa

began as a parent of a child at Children's Hospital of Illinois (CHOI), then a volunteer and program manager before transitioning into her current role. She has also worked as an attorney. Theresa began her presentation with a short "test your knowledge quiz" with prizes being awarded at the end. She shared some highlights of CHOI, and then talked about a new program they hope to have available by 2023. A pediatric critical care ground transport team would provide safer, more reliable and specialized pediatric emergency care for critically ill children. There are currently no ground transportation services that have a designated pediatric team. The initial service area would be an approximate 100 mile radius of Peoria. The estimated annual cost is \$500,000 for equipment, staff, and training, none of which is reimbursable by insurance. This

transport team has many benefits that Theresa shared. To emphasize the fact that children are not just "small adults," she displayed an infant's blood pressure cuff and a premie diaper - both of which were VERY small! In FY21, 546 pediatric patients were taken to CHOI, 1/3 by air and 2/3 by ground transportation since air transport is not always feasible. Anyone interested in more information or getting involved can contact Theresa or visit osfhealthcarefoundation.org. As the answers to the quiz were revealed, Rotarians were surprised to learn that CHOI in Peoria serves 24 counties, OSF owns 4 Life Flight helicopters, OSF has 24,000 ministry-wide, CHOI has 136 inpatient beds, and they provide 140 subspecialty services.
