Ambushed! The Assassination Plot Against President Garfield by Gail Jarrow (ALA nonfiction award winner for 2022, Jarrow uses historical documents, newspaper accounts, and diary entries to create an engaging chronology of events.)
The Woman All Spies Fear: Code Breaker Elizebeth Smith Friedman and Her Hidden Life by Amy Butler Greenfield (one of the finalists for 2022 ALA nonfiction award. With her work buried and credit given to others, female codebreaker Elizebeth Smith Friedman's life and accomplishments are given prime coverage. The book celebrates her intelligence, creativity, and tenacity during World War I and II and the legacy she leaves behind filled with intrigue, spying, and ciphers.)
In the Shadow of the Fallen Towers: The Seconds, Minutes, Hours, Days, Weeks, Months and Years After the 9/11 Attacks, written and illustrated by Don Brown (For a new generation living in a post-9/11 era, Brown writes and illustrates the events of the terrorist attack immediately after not only at Ground Zero but the country and military operations abroad. With a style that befits the mood, the combination of words and art shines.)
