**Community Wellness**

Chantha Chhim introduced Elizabeth Pratt, the co-founder and

Executive Director of Cornerstone Community Wellness in Sheffield. They opened as a 501(c)3 non-profit in 2015 and exist to help the people in their community grow in physical, emotional, and spiritual health. Elizabeth shared their services that currently include a 24 hour fitness center, healthy living classes, a community clothing shop, and childcare. Additionally, they provide some counseling and mental health classes. They are in the process of opening a grocery store, and Elizabeth talked about her experience in working with the current business owner to ensure that shopping can remain in this rural community. Elizabeth said that often times it is the most vulnerable populations that are left without resources when businesses close so it's important to address these issues. Statistically, Sheffield has 1,110 residents, and without a local store, residents will need to travel 10+ miles
