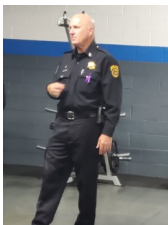

Chief Tom Kammerer
Princeton Police Dept.
Joe Kitchens introduced Chief Kammerer, a fellow Rotarian, who offered a tour of the local police

department. Some of the exercise room equipment was donated by our Club several years ago, and the on-site room made it possible for officers including County and State to continue to work out during the pandemic. Chief noted that "Lucy" the bloodhound is now a local resource for tracking lost and missing persons. A drone was purchased via a grant and has been helpful already, and the armored rescue vehicle was made possible through the State of Illinois and federal dollars. None of these used local tax dollars! Chief said a local task force allows for income from cash and drugs seized to be allocated to the local police department, and this has helped fund some squad cars. Having more cars in town increases the safety, even when not every vehicle is "on the clock." Chief said they hope to have a bracelet tracking program in place soon to help locate those with dementia, autism, etc. if they go missing. It

would be an opt-in program for those interested, but he has seen it be very successful in other areas. In other business, Chief noted that October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month at Freedom House. The "Living Room" established by Arukah has also opened at the St. Margaret's Clinic. This allows for walk-in mental health services and limits the need for emergency and police involvement in some situations. In the Q&A portion of the presentation, Chief noted that homelessness, mental health and the impact of Covid, illegal drugs, and testing/hiring for new officers are the biggest challenges his department faces.
