Tracy Grimmer introduced Mary VanKeulen, founder of the Believe Foundation, a

local 501(c)3 organization that began in 2008. Mary thanked Rotarians for monies they have received through the "Love our Community" grant and talked about how this has helped so many people. The Believe Foundation is the result of Mary seeing clients leave her hair salon after a diagnosis of cancer when they were losing their hair or asking for her advice and what to do when that time came. They have been able to customize wigs and now personally fit clients with post-op surgical needs. All money stays locally, and Mary said the smiles they see make it all worthwhile. Mary introduced Kelly Eiken who then shared her story. Her mom battled cancer and upon her passing, they donated memorial money to The Believe Foundation. Now, her husband has been diagnosed with terminal brain cancer, and they have been the recipient of gas cards which have been extremely helpful as they were traveling to Northwestern Hospital and

She talked about the cold cap system and said they have been able to purchase two of them; they work by freezing cells so the chemo doesn't penetrate them, lessening hair loss. Mary reminded everyone that it is Breast Cancer Awareness Month and time for mammograms and bloodwork. She concluded with a Q&A session where she mentioned their service area of Bureau, LaSalle, Putnam, and Henry Counties and some fundraising they are doing, as well as some local partnerships to meet the needs of their clients.
