**February 7 Program**  
**Dennis Taylor**  
**Taylor's Way**  
Josh Taylor introduced Dennis, the Director of Operations and Head Arborist. Both Josh and Dennis are fellow Rotarians. Dennis shared a variety of services that Taylor's Way has available including lawn care, tree care, pest control, outdoor permanent lighting, and holiday lighting. They added lighting to their services just this past year. Dennis discussed tips for caring for your trees and keeping them healthy. Many of the issues they see with trees involve improper planting or watering, nutrient deficiencies, improper pruning, wind burn, and insects. During his presentation, Dennis shared a slide that shows how Taylor's Way has given back to the community, and it included sites such as Rotary Park, the Prouty Building, and the Bureau County Fairgrounds. He briefly talked about Inception Lighting which is the permanently installed decorative lighting for homes, and he showed some projects that had been completed. Taylor's Way has been family owned since 1973, and
