Bob Mullane introduced Rod Thorson, the morning show host for WLPO. Rod shared that he has 31 years of broadcasting experience, beginning in 1992 as a farm broadcaster. His degree focused on agriculture, and he had no background in radio. Rod said that his job is to help businesses build business while entertaining his listeners. The goal is to connect with people whether he is sharing a story, problem-solving or talking about a cause. He uses Aristotle's "mode of persuasion" - ethos (credibility), pathos (emotional), and logos. (logical) or as Rod said courage, smarts, and love. These factors create a powerful connection in most any situation, personal life, and movies. He shared the plot of "Wizard of Oz" and how it includes all of the above.
