Joe presented his presidential year-end wrap-up, beginning with the Club's accomplishments. A number of service projects included serving dinner and a Christmas drive for Second Story, helping out at The Closet, Rotary park clean-ups, a landscape project at Zearing Child Enrichment Center and Greenfield, serving Thanksgiving meals at Gateway Services, delivering poinsettias to area nursing homes, updating Rotary signs at the entrances to the city, organizing the community Easter egg hunt, and preparing mobile crisis kits for Arukah. Fundraisers included lunch in the park, selling nuts, blacklight bingo, serving food at a street concert, "Share the Night" at Culver's, and ShrimpFest - not to mention Happy Dollars, personal donations, and giving through the Foundation. We were able to fund 10 "Love Our Community"

grants at \$1,000 each, and we gave out 4 - \$2,500 scholarships and 2 - \$500 scholarships. In summary, we gave a lot of time, energy and resources. And we raised a lot of funds, awareness, and joy! Joe went on to talk about the impact locally in Princeton, our nation, and our world. In closing, he shared that he will be stepping down from Rotary for a year, but he plans to return to the Club. Joe thanked everyone for making it a great year and said he was proud to be a Rotarian. Joe Park, incoming President, presented Joe with a plaque in appreciation for his year of service as our Club President.
