 Brea Cinnamon,  
 Fueling a Future**

Cathy Foes introduced Brea

Cinnamon, cofounder of the non-profit "Fueling a Future." They aim to ease the financial burden of transportation costs for children requiring medical care. Illinois families in areas surrounding Bureau, Henry, and Stark Counties can request gift cards for fuel purchases to attend appointments. Brea and her husband formed the 501(c)3 in 2020 after making 2 - 3 trips per week from Kewanee to the Peoria or Chicagoland areas for medical trips. Their daughter, Lauren (who "helped" her mom with the program), was born in 2018 and had 2 open heart surgeries and a brain surgery by the time she was 3. Many people helped the family out with travel expenses so they knew this is something they wanted to do. Since its inception, Fueling a Future has given out \$19,000 in gas cards! The rural aspect of their service area is most important to them, and they just want everyone to spread the word about this resource. There are no

financial restrictions, but children must be under the age of 18. There is a short application form, and proof of a medical appointment must be provided. Families can seek assistance more than once. Instead of spending money on gas, families can go out to eat or use the money elsewhere to make the medical trip a little more bearable. Brea said they have provided gas cards to help families go to Boston, California, Chicago and the surrounding suburbs, Peoria, St. Louis, and Iowa City.
