August 1 Program
Stephanie Eddens,
Senior Behavioral
Wellness Program
 Cathy Foes introduced Stephanie Eddens, Director of the Senior Behavioral Wellness program at OSF St. Clare Medical Center. The program offers Medicare recipients age 65 and older group and/or individual counseling. Group counseling helps seniors realize others have similar difficulties and they are not alone. This program has been available for 8 years and was previously part of Perry Memorial Hospital. Stephanie noted that depression and anxiety are typical issues seen in counseling, but many seniors experience health related challenges and don't "bounce back" as quickly as they did when they were younger. Some seniors also experience financial issues or other concerns about loss of relationships, hopelessness, increased forgetfulness and confusion, lack of energy, etc. A psychiatrist is available via telehealth, in addition to the onsite counselors. If someone does not have Medicare, staff can make referrals to other programs if needed.
