Eric May introduced Dave Emerick, our 2023-2024 District Governor from the East Moline/Silvis Rotary Club! Dave began with a message from RI President Gordon McInally that was shared during training in January. He wants to promote peace, help those affected by conflict, and maintain the momentum of initiatives begun by past leaders. The Rotary theme this year is "Create Hope in the World." The three initiatives are mental health, promoting peace, and empowering women and girls. There is a continued focus on polio eradication as well. Dave reviewed the strategic plan for the District and the 5 components: membership, foundation, public image, service, and operations. Each area has goals which were also mentioned. District 6420 has 43 clubs with approximately 1,400 members! Dave took the time to acknowledge our Rotary Club for

winning the World Series of Giving competition last year. He also commented on the district grant and our support of the Care-Trak system for the Princeton Police Department. This year, the district-wide service project is to fill food pantries. The goal is 20 pounds of food per Rotarian which would amount to about 28,000 total pounds! Our club is well on its way to our goal, with another event planned in the spring. Dave believes Rotarians will rise to the challenge, as last year's goal with book donations was far exceeded. Dave reminded us of the upcoming District Foundation dinner on November 2nd and the District Conference that will be held April 26th and 27th in Moline. He concluded his presentation with a quote by Jonas Salk, the scientist who developed the first successful polio vaccine: "Hope lies in dreams, in imagination and in the courage of those who dare to make dreams into reality."

Today is World Polio Day

Because of Rotary's support, nearly 3 billion children have been immunized against polio and are protected for life against this crippling disease. Rotary and our partners reduced the number of wild polio cases from 350,000 in 1988 to 140 in 2020. Twenty million cases of paralysis have been averted through this global effort. Rotary is committed to raising \$50M every year for polio eradication. Through our partnership with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, every \$1 of that is matched 2-to-1. With our members, we've contributed more than \$2.6B to fight polio, including matching funds from the Gates Foundation, and Rotary volunteers have dedicated countless hours to protecting children everywhere.
