As part of our celebration of veterans, Pam Pratt Marsh introduced Tom Root who has 33 years of Army and IL Army National Guard experience. Tom went through the ranks from Private to Command Sergeant Major. His family has a history of serving their country - beginning with his grandpa, father, and uncles - and that is what drew Tom to enlist. He shared his Army experiences and deployments before his honorable discharge, getting married and having 3 sons, and then enlisting in the IL Army National Guard for duty, honor, and country. At the time, his young sons didn't understand because Tom was gone from home so much and missed "life" as it was happening there. Years later, however, all 3 sons served. Tom talked proudly of their military experiences and said one of his highlights was pinning Captain bars on his son while they were both serving in Iraq. Tom said he is a better person because of his military experience, and he thanked his "battle buddies" and his country. He said he

Paul Harris Fellow recognition is given to anyone who contributes at least \$1,000 to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or an approved global grant. This recognition, which consists of a certificate and pin, can also be given on behalf of someone else. More than 1.6 million people have become Paul Harris Fellows since 1957, including notable figures such as former US President Jimmy Carter, former Russian President Boris Yeltsin, and polio vaccine developer Dr. Jonas Salk. Our club members are recognized with a "F" in front of their name! The Paul Harris Society recognizes people who commit to contributing \$1,000 or more each YEAR to any of the above funds. The society's purpose is to honor and thank people for their generous and ongoing support of The Rotary Foundation. Paul Harris Society contributions count toward several different kinds of individual recognition, and members receive a chevron-style pin and a certificate. Members are also listed in the Paul Harris Society Report.
