Bureau, Putnam & Marshall County Health Departments

**September 3 Program
Pat Schou**

Pat Schou shared information about the Bureau County Health Department and rural health today. She introduced Hector Gomez, administrator for the health department and talked about her 50 years of experience as a nurse and executive director of ICAHN. Pat noted that public health has existed in some form for many years going back to references in the Bible. In 1756, there was treatment for scurvy; and in 1796, there was the discovery of the smallpox vaccine. Later, there was pasteurization and treatments for rabies, malaria, plagues, flu, and polio. National public health services began in 1798, but it wasn't until 1877 that Illinois had a State Board of Health. The Bureau County Health Department started in 1991 and in recent years has encompassed Marshall and Putnam Counties. Their key services are disease prevention, family health, environmental health, health education, mental health, and emergency preparedness. Many people don't know that the health department is responsible for restaurant inspections, and they do about 50 each month, with 2 - 3%

needing to be repeated due to their score. Other services available at the local health department include lab work, pregnancy testing, WIC, lead testing, and well testing. Pat touched briefly on the IPLAN, a local assessment of needs that is completed every 5 years. This examines outcomes and helps identify critical needs for the counties. The Bureau County Health Board plans to establish a rural health clinic at the health department where they will provide specialty clinics and care for Medicare and Medicaid patients. Services will include primary care, women's health, outpatient lab, and dental. The goal is to open in December 2024. Pat wrapped up with the rural health landscape, noting that rural communities often have an older and sicker population and chronic diseases. Healthcare is changing with a team approach and added services such as telemedicine, but it's important that rural providers are involved in all discussions to ensure needs are met.
