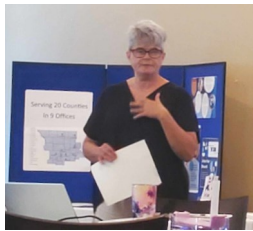

Beth Peacock introduced Beth Osmond to share information about

YSB. They are a child welfare organization with almost 50 years of service and they have 9 offices that serve 20 counties in Illinois. Their mission is helping young people and families succeed by serving them in their home, school and community. Foster care is their largest program, and the goal is to return kids home. Beth shared their statistics that show 522 foster care homes and 624 children in foster care. Intact Family Services include education, counseling, and advocacy and working with families so kids can remain safely at home. Referrals are made by DCFS. Solutions Counseling is intensive, outpatient mental health treatment provided by therapists specializing in working with adults, couples, children and families. Beth said their parenting program includes 12 weeks of classes and is currently available online and in Rockford. Juvenile Justice provides an

alternative to incarceration and is less expensive and more successful. YSB's program for runaway and homeless youth provides mediation with families, as well as emergency foster care if needed. Outreach counseling is available for ages 16 - 21 living without support in an unstable home. Kids are linked to area services, taught independent living skills, and assisted with finding jobs. Hispanic Services are based in Mendota, and they serve over 1,000 families annually. That number has increased due to an influx of more immigrants in that area. There are a number of ways for people to get involved. Donations are used to fund "compassion in action," allowing YSB to meet needs that fall outside of state-funded services. Beth shared an example of how an air conditioner was purchased for a grandparent that was caring for a child with asthma. YSB is always seeking board members to help support their work, and they always have a need for foster parents.
