September 17 Program Gateway Services

Our meeting was held on site at Gateway Services and began with a picture slideshow. Tracy Wright (CEO) shared how Rotary and Gateway had collaborated for many years. There was a photo of Paul Kautz, previous Executive Director and fellow Rotarian, leading a tour of Gateway for the men of Rotary in 1981 before women were allowed to be included. Then, beginning in 1985, Rotarians helped Gateway with the annual Phone-A-Thon fundraiser. In more recent years, Rotary has supported the individuals at Gateway by sharing cards on Valentine's Day and preparing and delivering Thanksgiving meals, something that was organized by the Community Service Committee. Gateway has also been the recipient of donations - now known as "Love Our Community" grants over the years, and these gifts were used to further support individuals and fill a gap where State of Illinois funding fell short. Gateway was also excited to be the recipient of a District grant which allowed for small appliances and kitchen gadgets for the newly remodeled
