 Pam Pratt-Marsh arranged for Jim Dunn to share the story: "Saved by JFK: How a Future President Rescued a Wyanet Native from the Shipwrecked PT 109." Jim is an excellent story teller and introduced us to Patrick

Henry McMahon who was onboard the PT109. He was nicknamed "Pappy" as he was the oldest member of the crew at 37. During WWII, they were serving on PT 109 in the Solomon Islands, and JFK was in charge. In the early morning hours of August 2, 1943, they were run down by a Japanese destroyer, and the boat was cut in half. Two sailors were killed and two were badly injured. Survivors swam to a nearby island and JFK towed McMahon by his life jacket strap to safety. They were rescued days later. The incident became well known after JFK became president, and a movie was also made. McMahon worked in car sales and then as a letter carrier before becoming Postmaster General in Cathedral City, CA. He passed away in 1990. Jim has a way with
