 Magi Baby Chest**

Shannon Merkel introduced Jessica Murphy and Ashley Gray to talk about Magi Baby Chest. They are located in the former school building at St. Louis Catholic Church in Princeton. Magi Baby Chest wants to provide families with baby supplies in a radically hospitable way just as the three Magi did for the infant Jesus. Everything at Magi Baby Chest comes from generous donors in the surrounding communities and is organized by amazing volunteers. They are open on the first Saturday of each month, and there is a suggested donation of \$5.00 but no family is turned away. Magi Baby Chest is available to families in Bureau County, and they offer supplies for newborns to age 4. At each visit a family is given a certificate worth 10 coupons, and these are good for any new item. All items are marked indicating their coupon value. Families are also allowed 5 - 10 each of any gently used items per visit at no cost. New items include diapers, formula,

clothes, car seats, high chairs, medicine, toys and bath items. A favorite of families that visit are the handmade items like blankets and burp towels. When the Magi Baby Chest opened in October 2022, only 15 families came through. Now they see 180 - 200 families each month. Since their start, there have been 3,518 total visits to the site. They have given away over 60,000 diapers, 520 cans of formula, 108 car seats, over 4,000 jars of baby food, and over 9,000 new infant articles of clothing. Magi Baby Chest has its own link on the church website (www.stlouisprinceton.org) and they have a Facebook page. They welcome donations and volunteers!
