January 27 Program
 Jenica Cole introduced Fran Wilsak, founder of Sole Encounters. She has a background in Animal Science and a 17-year career in Radiology. After overcoming stage 3 breast cancer, Fran experienced the profound healing power of simply being with her horse, and that led her to become a Licensed Equine Facilitator through the Touched by a Horse program. She hosts customized individual sessions or group workshops in Princeton, helping participants achieve personal growth, create unique memories, and connect with nature. Spending ground-based interactive time with her horses is an opportunity to give a fresh perspective and have some fun with her horse partners. Fran grew up in Chicago and moved to Downers Grove after getting married. At some point, she began riding horses again. She and her husband bought a second home in Princeton, described as a horse property, and they fell in love with it, moved here, and she wanted to share her horses with others. Fran shared a PowerPoint with photos of her partners/horses. She said they are just like

people with different likes and dislikes and quirks. Horses are masters at reading body language and feeling energy. They live in the moment and teach us to slow down. They also connect us to nature and inspire awe. Fran feels they can reflect our feelings and behaviors back to us and we can learn about ourselves. Fran talked about the process of arranging a group workshop or individual session. It's important for her to know the goals before proceeding. Some people want to sharpen leadership skills while others want to celebrate a family occasion. Anyone can participate, and experience with horses is not required. Sessions start with a safety talk and understanding a horse's body language. Fran uses a total of 18 exercises depending on the goal, and she talked a bit about these. Fran has pastures and paddocks, trails, and an area for various sessions and can accommodate for the weather. She hopes everyone can help her spread the word about her business and would love to host anyone who is interested. For more information, visit solencounters.com. 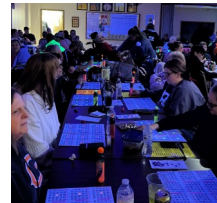
