**THE PERFECTLY FLAWED FOUNDATION February 10 Program**

Jene Kinsley introduced Luke Tomsha (founder) and Matt Rowlee (director of outreach) from The Perfectly Flawed Foundation. Luke shared that they are not a clinical organization, and they meet people where they are. There are a number of barriers for many users including felony records, incarceration, lack of housing, limited treatment programs, "mugshots" and names shared on social media and in the news. Luke said many people have no self worth and the problem can be multi-generational. This is why it's so important to provide support without judgment. Luke shared his personal story and that he began to use at age 25 and was in and out of treatment for 14 years. Stigma kept him in the shadows. He said telling his family and friends of his addiction got the "monkey off his back" and allowed him to move forward. In 2015, he quit heroin after attending a "retreat" that opened his eyes to other treatment options; their focus was on joy and happiness. There are many types of treatment and not all disease-based models. Luke started a blog to write about his experiences and decided he did not want to return to the technology field as he

found no joy there. He continued to blog, sold t-shirts for funds so others could seek treatment and, from there, Perfectly Flawed became a reality. Their focus is on harm reduction, overdose prevention, and peer support. They serve 13 counties with mobile outreach. Matt became part of the team in 2023. He talked about the peer led peer driven approach, hosting support groups and a small meal, and having "boots on the ground." Sometimes, it's enough to just listen and let people know you are there. People are made aware of services and supports available, but they may not be ready to give up substance use; however, they are willing to listen and that can be the first step toward change. They have a non-crisis text line available and can provide educational training for businesses and organizations. Luke is also very involved in advocacy efforts. 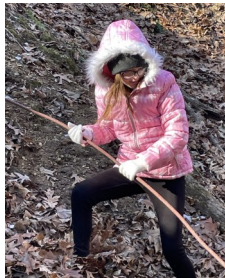
