 **May 12 Program**  
 Tonya Fitzpatrick, fellow Rotarian, has been with Freedom House for 3 years. She shared that Freedom House was established by Nedda Simon in 1983. She was a family and drug/alcohol counselor and recognized the number of women in counseling with bruises who were in denial about their domestic situation. She changed the conversation to "when were you last beaten" and quickly found success in women opening up about their lives. Freedom House began in an undisclosed location in Wyandot and moved to Euclid Avenue in Princeton in late 1989 in order to expand. They have been in their current location since 2001 and purchased the property in 2021. There are 10 separate rooms, 2 of which are family suites. They have 28 beds in the emergency shelter. Additionally, Freedom House has satellite offices in Geneseo, Lacon, Kewanee, and Cambridge. The agency serves 5 rural counties with a total population of 110,000: Bureau, Henry, Marshall, Putnam, and Stark. Freedom House is a not-for-profit and receives their funding through state and federal grants, along with donations. All

services are free. They pride themselves in offering trauma informed care, and they are all-inclusive meaning they support, women, men, children, and the LGBTQ community. Services include counseling for sexual and domestic violence, legal and medical advocacy, shelter services, case management and planning, and prevention education in grades K - 12. Statistically 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men will experience domestic or partner-related violence in their lives. Many feel shame and will never report. Additionally, it takes about 8 times before a victim will leave their abuser. The hotline is available 24/7 and connects directly with Freedom House personnel. They are judgement-free and take whatever time is needed to assess needs and provide a safe place. They are on target to open another emergency shelter in June in Kewanee!
