June 23 Program

President Steve Bouslog presided over his final noon meeting as President. He shared the goals that were established at the beginning of the Rotary year and noted the progress made. The first goal was to increase members by 2; we increased by 3. The second goal was to have 35 Rotarians involved in service projects; we fell short with only 17. Another goal was to complete 15 service projects; our Club completed 13. There was a goal to provide 258 hours of community service, and we exceeded that goal with 296 hours! The goal to contribute \$2,000 to the Foundation annual fund was exceeded with \$4,668. PolioPlus received an astonishing \$15,731 when our goal was \$3,000! A goal to hold 5 socials was met, as we had a total of 6. Our Club goal was to have 3 Rotarians sponsor new members, and we had 4. We met the goal to have an Interact Club. We hoped to have 3 attend the District Conference, and there were actually 4. The goal for 1 inbound youth exchange student was not met (but will be soon!) We planned to send 2 students to RYLA and had 3 in attendance. The goal for 6 media stories was met. Finally, the goal to have 4 Rotarians
